ACE coaching is:



Classroom-Level Support

Coaching directly addresses the teacher's classroom challenges and goals



Short-term

Bi-weekly or weekly coaching cycles



Targeted

Action-focused goals to support implementation of an identified coaching skill or practice



Individualized

Customized learning path to support training in identified focus areas



Remote or In-Person

Coaching sessions provided in-person and remote
