This virtual learning community is for school-based professionals (special educators, general educators, related service providers, etc.) focused on increasing academic, functional, and social communication skills for students with autism spectrum disorder (ASD). Participants in the VLCA will learn alongside others through a series of practice-based learning opportunities on the following objectives:

- Identify and assess the evidence-based practice (EBP)
- Plan and develop supports around the specific EBP
- Increase classroom implementation of targeted EBP
- Discuss and share resources to assist with implementation and evaluation

Antecedent-Based Interventions -- January 13 to February 7, 2025

Systematic Instruction -- February 17 to March 14, 2025

Reinforcement -- April 28 to May 23, 2025

Social Communication -- July 14 to August 8, 2025

Participation will advance both knowledge and skills through:

- Independent online content as well as classroom/field-based implementation activities.
- Virtual meetings via Zoom each Tuesday during the 4-week session to facilitate practice opportunities and group coaching. (All sessions are from 3pm - 4pm ET)
- Opportunities to collaborate and network with fellow school-based professionals across the state.

Upon completion of the 4-week session, a certificate will be sent via email to participants who have met all VLCA requirements.
